low Programme in Management be equivalent to any PhD programme (in management) worldwide... The programme will be fully-funded and students will receive a stipend of up to ₹7 lakh every year," ISB's Dean Ajit Rangnekar said.

A full-time programme, FPM would be for a period of four to five years. With this programme, ISB would focus on creating research-focused people, who would qualify for faculty positions in top business schools.
