HCL Technologies Ltd. has brought Roshni Nadar Malhotra on the company's board. Roshini is the daughter of the company's founder Shiv Nadar. She was appointed as the company's additional director on July 29, 2013. Roshni had so far been associated with the group's philanthropic activities through the Shiv Nadar Foundation. For the current financial year, the industry body Nasscom expects software exports to grow by 12-14 percent. The growth numbers so far clocked by HCL Tech suggest that it will surpass the industry expectations for the current financial year.
